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AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable.

The applicant appeared and testified before the Discharge Review Board (DRB), without counsel, at Andrews AFB on 27 Mar 2007. No witnesses testified on the applicant's behalf.

The following additional exhibits were submitted at the hearing:

Exhibit #5: Two character letters Exhibit #6: Letter of Appreciation and Patch from 2Lt [______] Exhibit #7: Certificate – Participation in Columbus AFB DEFY Program

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that neither the evidence of record nor that provided by the applicant substantiates an inequity or impropriety that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE:

Applicant contends his discharge was inequitable because his characterization was too harsh. The records indicated the applicant received two nonjudicial punishments under Article 15, UCMJ: (1) dereliction of duty by sleeping on post as a security forces member; by falling asleep while operating a patrol vehicle causing damage to a government vehicle and damage to an aircraft, false official statement; and (2) assault and battery of his active duty spouse, damage to his government housing, and failure to go to his place of duty), two Letters of Reprimand (one for dereliction of duty and lying, and another for driving his car without insurance and causing a domestic disturbance), a Letter of Counseling (for financial irresponsibility), had an unfavorable information file opened for his misconduct and was placed on the control roster prior to his discharge. The DRB opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his negative behavior. The Board concluded the applicant's misconduct during his brief enlistment outweighed any positive contributions he made while serving on active duty. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and that the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge, thus the applicant's discharge should not be changed.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for Misconduct: Minor Disciplinary Infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32, *Military Retirements and Separations*, and AFI 36-3208, *Administrative Separation of Airmen*, paragraph 5.49. If my recommendation is approved, your service will be characterized as an Under Honorable Conditions (General) Discharge.

2. My reasons for this action are:

a. On or about 15 Sep 05, you assaulted another Airman by placing your hands upon her neck, grabbing her arms, and shaking her. You also negligently damaged your government quarters by slamming doors and throwing items against the wall. Finally, on 19 Sep 05, you failed to go at the time prescribed to your appointed place of duty. For these actions, you received your second nonjudicial punishment consisting of a reduction to Airman First Class, 14 days extra duty, and a reprimand.

b. On 6 Jul 05, you used your collapsible baton to clear your patrol vehicle from mud after you got the vehicle stuck while on duty. When questioned about using a weapon in such a manner, you made a verbal and written false official statement. For this incident, you received a Letter of Reprimend (LOR), dated 14 Jul 05. This LOR was placed in your pre-existing Unfavorable Information File (UIF), and you were placed on a Control Roster, on 3 Aug 05.

c. On or about 12 Dec 04, you dishonorably failed to pay your Military Star Card bill. For this incident, you received a Letter of Counseling (LOC), dated 11 Jan 05. Additionally, the amount of your debt was deducted from your military pay.

d. On or about 13 Nov 04, you were involved in a minor domestic disturbance in which you attempted to threaten your spouse, who was also another military member. Additionally, on or about 30 Oct 04, you operated your privately owned vehicle without having proper insurance on said vehicle. For these incidents, you received an LOR, dated 11 Jan 05.

c. On or about 13 Jul 03, you were derelict in the performance of your duties when you willfully failed to refrain from sleeping while on duty. By falling asleep while operating your patrol vehicle, you caused the vehicle to strike a parked aircraft, causing damage to the aircraft and your patrol vehicle. When questioned about the incident, you made a false official statement. For these incidents, you received your first nonjudicial punishment consisting of a suspended reduction to the grade of Airman, and suspended forfeiture of \$645.00 pay per month for two months.

3. Copies of the documents to be forwarded to the separation authority in support of this recommendation are attached. The commander exercising SPCM jurisdiction or higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the United States Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment. The separation authority will make the findings and recommendations required under 10 U.S.C. Section 2005(g).

4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel is available to assist you. Please contact the Area Defense Counsel at Maxwell Air Force Base, Alabama at DSN 493-2186 to arrange consultation with a defense counsel. You may also consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by $\frac{10.0c+05}{c+05}$ unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.

7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to 14 MDOS, 201 Independence Drive on <u>50e105</u>, at <u>430</u> hours for the examination.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use at the unit personnel office.
