AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2006-00335

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to General.

The applicant was offcred a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined to exercise this right. The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDINGS: Upgrade of discharge is denied.

The Board finds that evidence of record does not provide a sufficient basis in clemency for a change of discharge.

ISSUES:

The applicant's issues are listed in the attached brief.

The applicant received a Bad Conduct Discharge, a punitive discharge, as part of his sentence resulting from a Special Court-Martial conviction. Under the provisions of Section 1553, 10 USC, the only basis for a change of a Bad Conduct discharge is clemency. The applicant provided no evidence to which the DRB could review. The Board concluded the reason for the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate and did not warrant granting clemency.

CONCLUSIONS: The Discharge Review Board concluded that the applicant's punitive discharge by Special Court-Martial is appropriate under the facts and circumstances of this case and there is insufficient basis, as an act of clemency, for change of discharge.
