AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

FD-2008-00266

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable, to change the reason and authority for the discharge, and to change the reenlistment code.

The applicant appeared and testified before the Discharge Review Board (DRB), without counsel, at Andrews AFB on 02 Nov 2010. The following additional exhibits were submitted at the hearing:

Exhibit #5: Applicant's Contentions

Exhibit #6: two (2) Character reference letters.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDING: The Board denies the upgrade of the discharge, change of reason and authority for discharge, and change of reenlistment code.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: Applicant submitted no issues regarding the inequity or impropriety of his discharge. Applicant did persist in his denial of culpability for the misconduct addressed by command through the Article 15 action he received -- that is his failure to pay \$9,000.00 in rent to his Turkish national landlord. However, he provided no exculpatory information or evidence that was unavailable to his commander at the time the Article 15 was issued. Further, Applicant did not allege any improprieties in the processing of the Article 15 action. The DRB noted that Applicant had accepted the Article 15 forum after he had consulted with counsel and did not appeal his commander's subsequent finding of guilt. Thus, the DRB opined that the Article 15 was warranted and appropriate for the misconduct it addressed. Applicant also submitted that he should not be penalized indefinitely for a mistake he made when young and immature. The DRB acknowledged that the applicant was 31 years of age when the discharge took place, and he had never before rented an apartment or been required to pay for utility bills. Nonetheless, there is no evidence Applicant was immature or did not know right from wrong. The Board opined the applicant was older than the vast majority of first-term members who properly adhere to the Air Force's standards of conduct. The Board concluded that the negative aspects of the applicant's service outweighed the positive contributions he made in his Air Force career. The characterization of the discharge received by the applicant was found to be appropriate due to the misconduct.

CONCLUSION: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge and determines the discharge should remain unchanged.

SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum -- Board Hearing

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for A Pattern of Misconduct, Dishonorable Failure to Pay Just Debts according to AFFD 36-32, Military Retirements and Separations, and AFI 36-3208, *Administrative Separation of Airmen*, under the provisions of paragraph 5.50.4. Copies of the attached documents to be forwarded to the separation authority to support this recommendation are attached.

2. My reasons for this action are:

a. On 6 July 2006, you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR) for dereliction in the performance of your duties in that you failed to file your temporary lodging allowance (TLA) voucher every 10 days while residing in commercial billeting as it was your duty to do. You checked into commercial billeting on 31 May 2006, yet as of 6 July 2006 (36 days after check-in) you still had not filed a TLA voucher. You therefore could not pay the hotel bill when it was past due and tried to negotiate with the hotel manager for a later payment date. This action was included in your Unfavorable Information File (UIF).

b. On 22 June 2006, you received Nonjudicial Punishment (NJP) for dereliction of duty in not using your overseas housing allowance (OHA) for the purpose for which it was intended and dishonorable failure to pay a debt (your rent) for a total amount of \$9,000.00 over the period of July 2004 to June 2005. For this action you received a reduction of rank to Airman First Class (A1C) and a reprimand. This action was included in your UIF.

c. On 10 April 2006, you received an LOR for willful failure to pay your rent for a total amount of \$6,750.00 over the period of July 2005 to March 2006. This document established your UIF.

3. This action could result in your separation with a characterization of Under Other Than Honorable Conditions (UOTHC). I am recommending that you receive a UOTHC discharge. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or higher authority will make the final decision in this matter. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and will probably be denied enlistment in any component of the armed forces.

4. You have the right to:

- a. Consult legal counsel.
- b. Present your case to an administrative discharge board.
- c. Be represented by legal counsel at a board hearing.
- d. Submit statements in your own behalf in addition to, or in lieu of, the board hearing.
- e. Waive the above rights. You must consult legal counsel before making a decision to waive any of your rights.

5. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the Incirlik Medical Treatment Facility for a medical appointment at 1245 hours on 18 July 2006. **You must report to the 425th Air Base Group Command Support Staff to obtain a medical/dental clearance letter prior to your appointment.**

6. Military legal counsel, Capt [REDACTED] Area Defense Counsel at Incirlik Air Base, Turkey, 676-6908, has been obtained to assist you. An appointment has been scheduled for you to consult him on 18 July 2006 at 1500 hours, at Incirlik Air Base, Turkey. Instead of the appointed counsel, you may have another, if the lawyer you request is in the active military service and is reasonably available as determined according to AFI 51-201, Administrative of Military Justice. In addition to military counsel, you have the right to employ civilian counsel. The Air Force does not pay expenses incident to the employment of civilian counsel. Civilian counsel, if employed, must be readily available.

7. Confer with your counsel and reply, in writing, within 7 workdays, specifying the rights you choose to exercise. The statement must be signed in the presence of your counsel who also will sign it. If you waive your right to a hearing before an administrative discharge board, you may submit written statements in your own behalf. I will send the statements to the discharge authority with the case file to be considered with this recommendation. If you fail to respond, your failure will constitute a waiver of the right to the board hearing.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use at <http://www.e-publishing.af.mil> or at 425th Air Base Group Command Staff's office.

9. If you request a board and you fail to appear without good cause, your failure to appear constitutes a waiver of your right to be present at the hearing.

10. If you received advanced educational assistance, special pay, or bonuses, and have not completed the period of active duty you agreed to serve, you may be subject to recoupment.
