AIR FORCE DISCHARGE REVIEW BOARD DECISIONAL RATIONALE

GENERAL: The applicant appeals for upgrade of discharge to honorable. The applicant was offered a personal appearance before the Discharge Review Board (DRB) but declined and requests that the review be completed based on the available service record.

The attached brief contains available pertinent data on the applicant and the factors leading to the discharge.

FINDING: The Board denies the upgrade of the discharge.

The Board finds the applicant submitted no issues contesting the equity or propriety of the discharge, and after a thorough review of the record, the Board was unable to identify any that would justify a change of discharge.

ISSUE: The applicant submitted no issues regarding the inequity or impropriety of his discharge. The applicant does submit that he has not had any driving violations since May 2006, he has maintained employment since his discharge, and he has learned from his mistake regarding drinking and driving. The record indicates the applicant received one Vacation Action, one Article 15, one Letter of Reprimand, and two Records of Individual Counseling. His misconduct included failure to wear hearing protection, failed inspection, drinking alcoholic beverages within eight hours of reporting to work, and driving while intoxicated. The Board opined that through these administrative actions, the applicant had ample opportunities to change his behavior. They found the seriousness of the willful misconduct offset any positive aspects of the applicant's duty performance. The Board reviewed the entire record and found no evidence of impropriety or inequity to warrant an upgrade of the discharge.

CONCLUSION: The Discharge Review Board concludes that the discharge was consistent with the procedural and substantive requirements of the discharge regulation and was within the discretion of the discharge authority and the applicant was provided full administrative due process.

In view of the foregoing findings, the Board further concludes that there exists no legal or equitable basis for upgrade of discharge and determines the discharge should remain unchanged.



SUBJECT: Notification Memorandum

1. I am recommending your discharge from the United States Air Force for minor disciplinary infractions. The authority for this action is AFPD 36-32 and AFI 36-3208, Chapter 5, Section H, Paragraph 5.49. If your discharge is approved, your service will be characterized as honorable or under honorable conditions (general). I am recommending that your service be characterized as under honorable conditions (general).

2. The reasons for this action are:

a. On or about 9 Dec 03, you failed a spot check, leaving unit 91L-393 with the engine running and unattended on the Hot pits. For this misconduct, you received a Record of Individual Counseling (ROIC), dated 10 Dec 03.

b. On or about 1 Mar 05, you failed to wear hearing protection while servicing an aircraft. For this misconduct, you received a ROIC, dated 1 Mar 05.

c. On or about 21 Jul 05, you failed to wear hearing protection while servicing an aircraft. For this misconduct, you received a Letter of Reprimand (LOR), dated 25 Jul 05.

d. On or about 21 Apr 06, you failed to refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages within eight hours of reporting for work. For this misconduct, you received an Article 15, dated 23 May 06.

e. On or about 26 May 06, you physically controlled a vehicle, to wit: a passenger car, while drunk. For this misconduct, you received a Vacation Action, dated 6 Jun 06.

3. Copies of the documents to support this recommendation are attached and will be forwarded to the separation authority. The separation authority will make the findings and recommendations required under 10 U.S.C. 2005(g) regarding recoupment of education assistance funds, if applicable. The commander exercising special court-martial jurisdiction or a higher authority will decide whether you will be discharged or retained in the Air Force and, if you are discharged, how your service will be characterized. If you are discharged, you will be ineligible for reenlistment in the Air Force and any special pay, bonus, or education assistance funds may be subject to recoupment.

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4. You have the right to consult counsel. Military legal counsel has been obtained to assist you. I have made an appointment for you to consult Captain [REDACTED] Area Defense Counsel, 895-9530, 321 Cullen Street, at 14:30 hours on 20 June 2006. You may consult civilian counsel at your own expense.

5. You have the right to submit statements in your own behalf. Any statements you want the separation authority to consider must reach me by 1730 hours on 22 June 2006 ⁴¹³ unless you request and receive an extension for good cause shown. I will send them to the separation authority.

6. If you fail to consult counsel or to submit statements in your own behalf, your failure will constitute a waiver of your right to do so.

7. You have been scheduled for a medical examination. You must report to the 20th Medical Group, Primary Care Clinic at 9:30 hours on 21 June 2006 and an additional examination will be scheduled if necessary.

8. Any personal information you furnish in rebuttal is covered by the Privacy Act of 1974. A copy of AFI 36-3208 is available for your use in the unit orderly room.
