Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show entitled to Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH) for the Military Housing Area (MHA) for the Annapolis, MD area.
- The Board, consisting of Messrs. Beckett, McCulloch, and Taylor, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 February 2002 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. After reviewing the correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the Board concluded that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

## CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

- a. Petitioner was authorized BAH for dependents residing in MHA "128, which is the Annapolis, MD MHA" vice "129, which is the Baltimore, MD MHA" for the period 19 June 2000 through 12 September 2001. Only the MHA changed all other data pertaining to dependents remained the same.
  - b. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.
