- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show his lieutenant commander date of rank and effective date as 1 October 2001, the date he would have been assigned but for delay of his Senate confirmation. He currently has a 16 October 2001 date of rank and effective date.
- 2. The Board, consisting of Messrs. Kastner, Schultz and Zsalman, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 8 August 2002, and pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.
- 3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:
- a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.
- b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the Navy Personnel Command (NPC) office with cognizance over the subject matter of this case has commented to the effect that Petitioner's request has merit and warrants favorable action. They recommend changing his lieutenant commander date of rank (and by implication, effective date) to 1 October 2001.

## **CONCLUSION:**

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

- a. That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show his date of rank and effective date in the grade of lieutenant commander as 1 October 2001, vice 16 October 2001; and that his lineal precedence be adjusted accordingly.
- b. That any material or entries inconsistent with the Board's recommendation be corrected, removed or completely expunged from Petitioner's record and that no such entries or material be added to the record in the future.
- c. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed at an appropriate location in Petitioner's naval record, and that another copy of this report be returned to this Board, together with any material directed to be removed from Petitioner's record, for retention in a confidential file maintained for such purpose.
- 4. Pursuant to Section 6(c) of the revised Procedures of the Board for Correction of Naval Records (32 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 723.6(c)) it is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.

The delayed confirmation of the promotion list resulted in the listed officers being assigned a date of rank of 16 October 2001.
- 3. Recommend the dates of rank for all officers listed in reference (a) be changed to 1 October 2001.

- RMKS/1. THIS NAVADMIN IS THE AUTHORITY FOR EFFECTING TEMPORARY AND PERMANENT OFFICER PROMOTIONS. UNDER REF A, THE SECRETARY OF THE NAVY, ACTING FOR THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, APPOINTS PERMANENT REGULAR AND RESERVE OFFICERS TO THE GRADE OF LIEUTENANT COMMANDER IN THE LINE AND STAFF CORPS. PER REF B, THE SECRETARY OF THE NAVY TEMPORARILY APPOINTS LIMITED DUTY OFFICERS. THESE APPOINTMENTS ARE EFFECTIVE ON THE DATE INDICATED.
- 2. RESERVE OFFICERS SHOULD CONSULT REF C FOR INFORMATION CONCERNING TRANSFER TO THE REGULAR NAVY. DIRECT INQUIRIES TO NAVPERSCOM (PERS-801).
- 3. IF A COMMANDING OFFICER DETERMINES THAT AN OFFICER UNDER HIS OR HER COMMAND IS NOT MENTALLY, PHYSICALLY, MORALLY, OR PROFESSIONALLY QUALIFIED FOR PROMOTION, THE PROMOTION SHALL NOT BE EFFECTED. IF THIS IS THE CASE, THE COMMANDING OFFICER SHOULD NOTIFY THE OFFICER BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF APPOINTMENT, UNLESS IT IS IMPRACTICAL TO DO SO, IN WHICH CASE NOTIFICATION WILL BE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. REF D REQUIRES THAT SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION AND A STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICER BE FORWARDED IMMEDIATELY TO NAVPERSCOM (PERS-83), COPY TO NAVPERSCOM (PERS-8023).
- 4. OFFICERS CONSIDERING VOLUNTARY RETIREMENT SHOULD REVIEW REF E FOR

SERVICE OBLIGATION UPON ACCEPTING PROMOTION. OFFICERS ANTICIPATING RESIGNATION OR RELEASE FROM ACTIVE DUTY UNDER REF F MAY ACCEPT PROMOTION WITHOUT INCURRING ANY ADDITIONAL ACTIVE DUTY OBLIGATION.

- 5. PROVIDED THE OFFICER IS QUALIFIED UNDER PARA 3, THE COMMANDING OFFICER SHALL PREPARE AND HAVE THE OFFICER VERIFY AND SIGN REF I ACCEPTING OR DECLINING THE PROMOTION. OFFICERS LISTED BELOW WHO ARE APPOINTED UNDER REFS A OR B ARE CONSIDERED TO HAVE ACCEPTED SUCH APPOINTMENT ON THE DATE INDICATED UNLESS EXPRESSLY DECLINED IN WRITING. MAIL ONLY THE ORIGINAL OF REF G WITHIN 30 DAYS TO NAVPERSCOM (PERS-8023).
- 6. PROPOSED LEGISLATION IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2002 NATIONAL DEFENSE AUTHORIZATION ACT (NDAA) WOULD AUTHORIZE THE SECRETARY OF THE NAVY TO ADJUST THE DATE OF RANK OF THOSE OFFICERS BELOW WHO SHOULD HAVE BEEN PROMOTED ON 1 OCT 01. UPON ENACTMENT OF THE NDAA WITH THE PROPOSED LEGISLATION THE DOR OF THE OFFICERS BELOW WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE ADJUSTED TO 1 OCT 01
