1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a) Subject, hereinafter referred to as Petitioner, filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting, in effect, that the applicable naval record be corrected to show he reenlisted USN vice USNR.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Pfeiffer, Mr. Zsalman, and Mr. George, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 12 October 2010 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. In correspondence attached as enclosure (2), the office having cognizance over the subject matter addressed in Petitioner's application has commented to the effect that the request has merit and warrants favorable action.

#### CONCLUSION

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record, and especially in light of the contents of enclosure (2), the Board finds the existence of an injustice warranting the following corrective action.

RECOMMENDATION:

That Petitioner's naval record be corrected, where appropriate, to show that:

a. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), executed on or about 9 December 2000 is USN, vice USNR. The BRCL is 11, and RADO MONTHS/DAYS 000/000.

b. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), executed on or about 11 May 2004 is USN, vice USNR. The BRCL is 11, and RADO MONTHS/DAYS 000/000.

c. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621), executed on or about 24 March 2007 is USN, vice USNR. The BRCL is 11.


d. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the agreement to extend enlistment (NAVPERS 1070/621), operative on or about 11 June 2010 is USN, vice USNR. The BRCL is 11.

e. The Branch/Class (BR/CL) on the immediate reenlistment contract (NAVPERS 1070/601), executed on or about 13 August 2010 is USN, vice USNR. The BRCL is 11, SPI-TAR is blank, TAR-TEMAC is blank, EAOS is 12 August 2016, SEAOS is 12 August 2016, RADO MONTHS/DAYS 000/000, and EREN is blank.

f. A copy of this Report of Proceedings will be filed in Petitioner's naval record.


