1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Petitioner applied to this Board requesting his naval record be corrected to show that he was not discharged on 31 July 1985, but continued to serve until 1 August 1985.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Hotopp, Mr. Tew, and Mr. Lacroix, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 10 August 2011 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Petitioner enlisted in the Navy Reserve and entered active duty on 2 August 1983. He served honorably until 31 July 1985, one day prior to the end of his active obligated service date.

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants favorable action. In this regard, the Board believes that his record should show one day constructive service on his DD Form 214 for a total of three years continuous active duty.


RECOMMENDATION:

b. That a copy of this Report of Proceedings be filed in his naval record.


